

## **REMOVAL**

- 3. PLACE FRONT WHEELS FACING STRAIGHT AHEAD BC
- **REMOVE STEERING WHEEL COVER LOWER NO.3** (See page **RS-345**)
- **REMOVE STEERING WHEEL COVER LOWER NO.2** (See page RS-345)
- REMOVE STEERING PAD (See page RS-346) 6.
- 7. REMOVE STEERING WHEEL ASSEMBLY (See page **SR-8**)
- 8. REMOVE LOWER STEERING COLUMN COVER (See page SR-8)
- REMOVE UPPER STEERING COLUMN COVER (See page SR-8)
- 10. REMOVE SPIRAL CABLE (See page RS-357)
- 11. REMOVE STEERING ANGLE SENSOR
  - (a) Disconnect the steering angle sensor connector.
  - (b) Disengage the claw and disconnect the steering angle sensor connector and harness.





(c) Disengage the 2 claws and remove the steering angle sensor.



## **INSPECTION**

## 1. INSPECT STEERING ANGLE SENSOR

- (a) Check the steering angle sensor.If any of the following occurs, replace the steering angle sensor with a new one.
  - The surface of the steering angle sensor is cracked, dented or chipped.
  - The connector is scratched, cracked, or damaged.
  - The steering angle sensor has been dropped.
